1. EAN RESULTS

1.1. 2012 Final Account (Annex A)

Operating costs

The total amount of the 2012 operating costs is **80,162.09 €**.

The total workload for the management of the network is 76.25 days:

- Coordinator (CEPN):
 - 28.5 project leader person.days,
 - 0.25 senior researcher (web developer) person.days ,
 - 32.5 junior researcher person.days.
- Assistant coordinator (HPA):
 - 15 person.days.

53.25 person.days (56.9 k€ VAT included) will be paid to CEPN.

As a consequence 8.0¹ person.days have been supported by CEPN, as in-kind contribution. This is about 4 person.days less than in 2011.

19 k€ were paid to the assistant coordinator (HPA). This includes workload (15 days) and T&S costs.

Coordinator's T&S and other (mainly banking) costs represent 4,262.39 €.

Resources

After Germany and Belgium fees are paid, the 2012 EAN fees, received from 14 Administrative Board Members, will correspond to 79.3 k€. Moreover, the 14th Workshop in Dublin showed a surplus of 2,356.93 € which has been transferred by RPII to the EAN account. In 2012, the financial income is 587.94 €.

The total 2012 total resources are expected to be **82,244.87 €**.

Result

The 2012 accounts present a positive result of **2,082.78 €**.

2. EAN 2013 BUDGET

2013 operating costs and resources - Budget (Annex B)

Operating costs

The planned workload is the following:

- 55.5 person.days for CEPN which corresponds to 54.2 k€ for CEPN, plus 4.9 k€ for T&S and other costs,
- 15 person.days for HPA which corresponds to 19.0 k€ for HPA, including 2.5 k€ for T&S.

It is planned that 51.5 over the 55.5 corresponding person.days will be financed by EAN (about 45.3 k€ without VAT, 54.2 k€ VAT included): thus, the CEPN in-kind contribution should be 4 person.days. The budget is established considering the participation and travels in 2013 to two programme committee meetings in Croatia (preparation of the 15th EAN workshop).

The 2013 payment to HPA for its assistant coordinator works is still fixed at 19,000 €: it corresponds to 15 person.days, and 2,500 € for T&S.

There is no extra-budget planned for financing the EAN participation to any IAEA (RECAN/ARAN/REPROLAN...) workshop or ICRP meeting, at the moment.

The total amount for 2013 costs is then expected to be 78,128.80 €.

Resources

As in 2012, STUK (Finland) will not pay fees to EAN for 2013.

As a consequence, EAN is expecting to receive fees from 14 countries: Austria (Seibersdorf Labor GmbH - 3,000 € - **still uncertain**), Belgian contributors to EAN (5,800 €), Croatia (EKOTEH and Ministry of Health and Welfare - 4,000 €), Czech Republic (SUJB - 4,000 € - **still uncertain**), France (ASN - 7,000 €), Germany (BfS - 8,000 €), Greece (GAEC - 4,000 €), Ireland (RPII - 2,000 €), Norway (NRPA - 7,000 € **already paid**), the Netherlands (NRG - 7,000 €), Spain (CSN - 7,000€), Sweden (SSM -

7,000 € - **exact amount to be confirmed**), Switzerland (SFOPH - 6,500 €), and UK (HPA - 7,000 €).

These fees should be paid under the usual conditions in 2013.

The total amount of 2013 resources is then expected to be 79,300 €.
